The Lewabrane membrane separation elements made at the German Bitterfeld site for reverse osmosis (RO) are specially developed by LANXESS for industrial water treatment and the treatment of drinking water. The range currently includes products for the desalination of brackish and low-salinity waters. Main areas of application include the production of boiler feed water, wastewater treatment, groundwater remediation and full demineralization for microchip fabrication. The LANXESS range will be expanded this year to include additional product grades for seawater desalination. "The seawater membranes we developed are already undergoing extensive practice testing in Egypt," Scheffler says. "We therefore are confident that we will be able to stick to our schedule for the product launch at Singapore International Water Week, to be held in June 2014."

All Lewabrane membrane elements comply with NSF/ANSI Standard 61 for the health-related implications of drinking water system components. The U.S. National Sanitation Foundation (NSF International) has certified that all membrane elements currently sold by LANXESS are safe for use in the treatment of drinking water, a market segment with strong growth potential.
